
## **Assembly Instructions**

- 1. Cut out Styrofoam the size of the base.
- This increases stability and allows magnets to be attached at the bottom.
- 2. Glue the walls around the styrofoam. You can cut away the bottom flaps of the walls.
- 3. Glue the roof to the roof base.
- 3. Glue the roof base to the building if you do not need a removable roof.
- 4. (optional) Add layers of styrofoam inside the building to raise the floor. This way placing units inside is much easier.
- 5. (optional) Paint over the white paper seams with dark color to conceal the paper craft look.

## For a removable roof:

- 1. Cut away the top flaps on the walls.
- 2. Add Plastic Card supports beneath and to the sides of the roof base so that the roof can be inserted easier.(optional)








